

BELIZE PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

Minor (under 16 years of age)-First Application

All documents must be submitted in their original form.

Important points to note:

- All required fields within the application must be filled.
- All names and personal information must reflect exactly what is specified on the supporting documentation.
- Applicant refers to parent or legal guardian acting on behalf of the child who is under 16 years of age.
- Application Form should be hand written, and filled in by applicant (parent or guardian).
- Application needs to be signed by applicant (parent or guardian) on behalf of the child who is under 12 years of age.
- A child 12 years and older in addition to the parent or guardian, must sign the application form.

Form 4A

Must be endorsed by one from the below list.

- Belize Justice of the Peace
- Notary Public
- Attorney at Law

Form 4B

Must be endorsed by one from the below list

- Ambassador
- Consul General
- Deputy Chief of Missions (Embassy)

First Time Applicant

The applicant for a child under the age of sixteen must be either:

- a. The Parent
- b. The Legal Guardian

Supporting Documentation

**Documents not in English must be translated and notarized by a recognized entity.*

- Born Belizean: Original birth certificate
- Naturalized Belizean: Original Nationality Certificate
- Adopted: Adoption Certificate
- Name Change: Original Deed Poll (Registered in Belize)

❖ Additional Documentation

1. Photo Identification of applicant (parent or legal guardian) stating full name as it appears on:
 - a. Child's birth certificate
 - b. Child's adoption certificate
 - c. Child's nationality certificate
 - d.

Photo Identification for applicant (parent or legal guardian) in the form of:

- a. Valid identification card
 - b. Valid Passport

2. Two (2) Passport size photos, white background, 2x2 properly certified by each Recommender with the following quote; *"I certify that this is a true likeness of (include Applicant's full name" and be legible), signed and stamped.*

Time Frame: 6 to 8 weeks

FEES: US\$80.00 Payable by cash or money order made out to Embassy of Belize or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)
