

Replacement of Nationality Certificates

Transfer of Certificate from Parents

1. Declaration requesting the issuance of a separate nationality certificate.
2. Original nationality certificate of the parent, showing the child inclusion
3. US\$100 Fee Cash or Money Order made out to the Embassy of Belize or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)
4. 4 Photos (2" X 2") (In keeping with passport photo guidelines)
5. Copy of valid Belize passport or some form of photo identification

Regular Replacement (Certificates without photograph, DOB/damaged)

1. Original and a photocopy of nationality certificate
2. Copy of valid ID or Belize Passport.
3. Original Birth certificate & translation if applicable- for nationality certificates with no D.O.B or otherwise.
4. Declaration form requesting replacement of nationality certificate and reasons why
5. 4 photos (2"x2") (in keeping with passport photo guidelines)
6. US\$100 Cash or Money Order made out to the Embassy of Belize or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)

Lost Certificates

1. Police report attesting to the loss of the nationality certificate
2. Copy of certificate or if possible certificate number
3. Declaration form- requesting replacement and state how document was lost
4. Copy of valid I.D or valid Belize Passport
5. 4 photos (must be 2"x2" in size, taken with a frontal view, white background, no sleeveless and taken within the last six months) (passport photo guidelines)
6. US\$100 Cash or Money Order made out to the Embassy of Belize or relevant consular office (Miami, New York, Los Angeles or Chicago)

NB:

- Where the information cannot be found in ledger all documents **must** be submitted
- Ensure the correct spelling of names on documents.
- Both original and photocopies of documents must be presented.
- Correction liquid on application forms is not acceptable.
